Seminar conducted in January 2017

Seminar on "Experience Sharing on Effectiveness of NEC Contract" dated 23 January 2017

The captioned talk was jointly organized by HKICM and HKIVM held on 23 January 2017.

The talk was delivered by our Council Member Mr. KH Fok who fulfilled various roles in the civil engineering industry for over 30 years. His thorough grasp of the NEC3 and other forms of contract have helped in his successful management of more than 50 construction projects.

Mr. Fok mentioned that the Government of HKSAR had adopted the New Engineering Contract (NEC) for more than 50 public works and civil engineering projects since 2009 and would continue to use NEC for projects in future.

The seminar discussed the practical issues, existing common problems with possible solutions and recommendations for effective implementation of the NEC. He also specifically shared his findings on application of NEC Contract with regard to time, subcontracting, payment and compensation event. A question-and-answer session was held at the end of the talk and the talk was well received by participants

CPD Seminar: Holistic Risk Assessment Model for Target Cost Contract - A Reality or Myth?

The problems inherent with the traditional design-bid-build procurement method often lead to the adversarial working relationships within the construction industry. Target cost contracts, accompanied by a gain-share/pain-share arrangement serving as a cost incentive mechanism, have emerged in the United States, the United Kingdom, Australia and Hong Kong with the aim of achieving better value for money and more satisfactory overall project performance under a collaborative working relationship. Moreover, target cost contracts are considered to be a desirable procurement option where project risks are taken jointly by the employer and the contractor.

Based on 10 years of research and teaching experience in target cost contracts, the two guest speakers, Cr Dr Daniel W.M. CHAN and Sr Dr Joseph H.L. CHAN will share with the audience of this seminar their personal academic knowledge and useful research findings covering the following areas of target cost contracts.

WHY THIS COURSE?

A number of formal documents (WTBC16/1998; Tang2001; WTBC35/2002) strongly recommend a wider adoption of VM techniques in order to achieve excellence in the quality of construction products. However, qualified VM workshop facilitators are hard to come by in HK. To enhance the innovative team decision-making management techniques in construction industry, a full VM training workshop (module I) will be arranged in June vm usining workshop (module I) will be arranged in June 2017 by the Hong Kong Institute of Value Management.
